Treasurer	Checking: Balance - \$13,725.34* Revenue - \$35,725 (all teams paid only \$275 under anticipated budget, but with 11 SPEEA teams "loss" of \$1650 revenue but actual loss of \$660 paid to nationals for registrations) Expenses - • \$25,801.14* (except EWU will reimburse \$700 for pins or \$400 if BoD authorizes \$300 for 200 pins to go to teams advancing to nationals) • \$2,000 under "Misc" was \$ transferred to savings, so is not really an expense so deduct \$2,000 from actual expenses (and below). • *With \$700 reimbursement from EWU: Balance \$14,425.34; Expenses \$25,101.14 • With \$400 reimbursement from EWU: Balance \$14,125.34; Expenses \$25,401.14 Expected expenses for remainder of FY (and into Sept when revenue starts coming in): • Support for teams going to nationals - \$3,000 (unless lower amt per team authorized 4/30) COULD even authorize more - see surplus below. • WSO30 Pins (200) - \$300 - if approved by

	 BoD State Director Salary - \$2,500 State Director Travel to nationals - \$400 Postage/Office Supplies/Misc - \$100* *With online voting this year, will save at least \$100 in labels, envelopes and postage, but will need to purchase phone card for Annual Mtg teleconference, rules manual envelopes by Sept (approx. \$40) and postage to mail out. We should have ~ \$7400 surplus by the end of Sept. (mostly this is due to large # of teams this year and increased returning team fee) Savings: Balance \$11,154.57 \$1,961 earmarked for eastern region WSO = \$9,193.57 available for WSO. Note: While we had 11 SPEEA teams, none of the \$2500 deposited to savings has been touched not sure if want to earmark for anything. Transferred \$2,000 from checking to savings in Sept. Donations to date: \$3061.14 (w/\$2500 from SPEEA and \$250 designated for EWSO) Follow up with Dennis Davaz about Boeing matching \$300: He said he didn't know if he put in the request and probably couldn't at that point (January, following July contribution) haven't heard anything more, so not happening! Interest income: \$3.54
