- B. Unified schedule:
  - 1. Posted draft schedule: WSO Unified Schedule 2025
    - a) If we change our State Policy language to say that our schedule will be published by mid Sept we can look at National's and avoid conflicts. (But not until next year)
      - (1) Edie pointed out that only 2 teams have to deal with any conflict...
      - (2) Banny wondered about following National schedule in the future...it would be hard to study all year for an event then not be able to compete at Nationals
      - (3) Scott added that we normally publish early because teachers schedule in early Sept means they can't devote a lot of time to scheduling at that point. If we have a non-teacher to look at the schedule and align our schedule to Nationals, that would eliminate the conflict.
      - (4) Nationals might have the flexibility to run similar B/C events at the same time while we need to have B/C use the same space and not run at the same time.
